



The 8th Grade Trip to Six Flags Discovery Kingdom Wednesday, June 1, 2022

Leave school at 9:00 a.m. and return 5:00 p.m. (depending on traffic)

Eighth Graders will attend the 8th Grade trip to Six Flags Discovery Kingdom on June 1, 2022. We are asking for a donation of \$80 with a signed District permission slip found in this packet to cover tickets, lunch and bus cost. **This will need to be returned to CWMS no later than Friday, April 1, 2022.** Checks can be made to **Charlotte Wood Middle School** or you can purchase your student's ticket from the CWMS Store found on the CWMS website.

If a student has a season pass to Six Flags, we are asking for a donation of \$55 to cover the mandatory bus transportation and lunch. Parents and teachers will accompany students on each bus. Students are to be on the buses to return to school by 2:30 pm. The buses will leave the park at 3:00 pm. If any discipline problem occurs during the trip, parents will be called by an administrator to drive down and pick up their student.

This trip to Six Flags is a privilege. Students who have not met promotion requirements are not eligible to attend. The following criteria must be met before students may attend:

Academic Expectations (Per District Policies):

- Students with no more than one semester F are eligible for all activities
- Students with more than one F are not eligible for Six Flags and may not be eligible for the ceremony
- Grade eligibility date is May 25, 2022.

Behavioral Expectations:

We expect students to be on their best behavior between now and the promotion ceremony. Behavioral expectations for the activities are as follows:

- One suspension: ineligible for Six Flags
- Two suspensions: ineligible for Six Flags and the Party
- Three or more: ineligible for all (Six Flags, Party, Ceremony)

Participation at all events per these guidelines is subject to the discretion of site administration.

We need parents to help chaperone. You will need to go online to the **SRVUSD Volunteer System**. If you choose to chaperone, all the paperwork must be complete and filled out online with the district.

Note: No donation for any of the promotion activities is mandatory for participation. However, if total donations do not cover the cost of the trip, we will be unable to run the trip. Since donations go to the total cost of the trip for ALL students, we are unable to issue refunds for donations.
